### Don Irwin Report

March has begun very unseasonably warm which has been enjoyed by students able to be outside and parents rejoicing.

Each year the Board attends the symposium on rural education in early March with this year's theme being ensuring equity among of opportunity among all rural and urban students and schools.

Classified staff we're giving a 3% salary adjustment in March.

We are trying three new programs for the fall to being S.T.E.M (science, technology engineering and mathematics) full-time kindergarten at West Hosford School and Mundare and a full-time kindergarten French immersion in Fort Saskatchewan.

We are conducting our annual survey of parents to get your valuable input into current and future programs in the district.

Transportation Grant is changing as the government is increasing the minimum distance to 1.6 km before funding any transportation up from the current 1.0. this will affect rates for the new for the next year.

The Alberta school council association (ASCA) is conducting their annual conference with registrations being paid for by your School District and all sessions online.
